It's good to get back to business after the international break. The Blades arrive at Elland Road in second place in the league table for what should be a very competitive derby game.

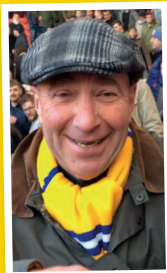
C'mon Leeds!
