

Leeds have been linked to French strike ace Florian Maurice of Marseille. It is reported that the French international is unsettled at the Velodrome stadium side. It waits to be seen whether there are any developments in this link to the 25 year old hitman or whether it is just a case of weekend speculation, with it well known that Leeds are in the hunt for a striker.

If Leeds are indeed keen on the former Paris St Germain star, they could face competition, with it reported that Maurice has also caught the attention of Premiership rivals Derby, Sunderland and Leicester. As regards a price tag for Maurice, a figure of £2.5 million has been mentioned

Spanish wonder kid linked

There's a few more details on the Spanish defender who we told you yesterday was linked to the club. Jordi Ferron, is apparently a wonder kid who plays for Barcelona but it currently on loan at Rayo Vallecano who top the Spanish league. He's either a midfielder or a central defender depending on who you believe. He's played just 11 games this season mostly from the subs bench and he's scored four goals. He apparently has a clause in his contract which allows him to speak to clubs who offer £3.5 million for his services and both Leeds and Liverpool are said to be keen but the link was originally in a Spanish paper and is unlikely to be based on any fact.
