

### Haaland's plea

Alfie Haaland has issued a plea to Leeds not to place too high a valuation on him. The 27 year old has found first team opportunities hard to come by this season, and has admitted it is a situation he is beginning to find frustrating. First Division high-flyers Manchester City are a club who have been linked to the Norwegian international, and about the Maine Road outfit Haaland says that they are a "very interesting club". But the midfielder is hoping that Leeds do not put a price tag on him that would put off any clubs who may show an interest in him.

Haaland commented: "I just hope Leeds do not scare away any potential buyers by overpricing me."

### Leeds linked with Gudjohnsen bid

David O'Leary has been linked with a £5million bid for Bolton striker, Eidur Gudjohnsen, who is also being targeted by Sunderland. Both clubs sent scouts to watch the Icelandic hitman score in the Trotters' recent victory over Lancashire rivals Blackburn Rovers, with the Wearsiders also sending a scout to watch the player in action against Port Vale in midweek. Bolton boss Sam Allardyce is desperate to keep his 15-goal marksman and has already knocked back a £4million bid from Derby County. But he knows he will be powerless to prevent the striker from leaving the Reebok if the club fails to fulfill his Premiership ambitions by the end of the season.

Leeds have so far refused to comment on the link to Gudjohnsen, but Sunderland are known admirers and, at present, remain favourites to lure the player to the Stadium of Light, where boss Peter Reid wants to establish competition for Kevin Phillips and Niall Quinn.

### The Judas Re-Union Club

Jimmy Floyd Hasselbaink has hinted that he would like to sign for Spurs in order to link up once again with his old mentor, George Graham. Jimmy now with Atletico Madrid, could leave the Spanish outfit in a row over payments, with talk that the Dutch international will be available on a free transfer in the summer. The striker - top scorer in Spain with 20 goals - is still owed nearly £2m in wages and signing on fees, and has already targeted a reunion with his former boss at Leeds, Graham.

It was Graham who plucked Hasselbaink from obscurity by paying Boavista £2m for him in the summer of 1997.

The 27 year old striker, also linked with a move to Barcelona, said: "Some clubs will pay an awful lot of money, but then there are some great coaches who you always want to play for." George Graham is one of those coaches. Remember Spurs also have on their books the Dutch striker Korsten.
